CIB New Issue Encouraged Journal Off-site Construction and Design for Manufacture

Off-site construction and design for manufacture has come increasingly to the fore in the national conversation concerning desired improvements in construction sector productivity, quality and safety. Last November HM Treasury published a policy paper that said with reference to infrastructure delivery '...the Department for Transport, the Department of Health, the Department for Education, the Ministry of Justice, and the Ministry of Defence will adopt a presumption in favour of offsite construction by 2019 across suitable capital programmes, where it represents best value for money'.

The select committee was interested to learn of the potential benefits of off-site manufacture in construction, obstacles to wider adoption, potential contribution to sector productivity and sustainability, and the role of public procurement.
