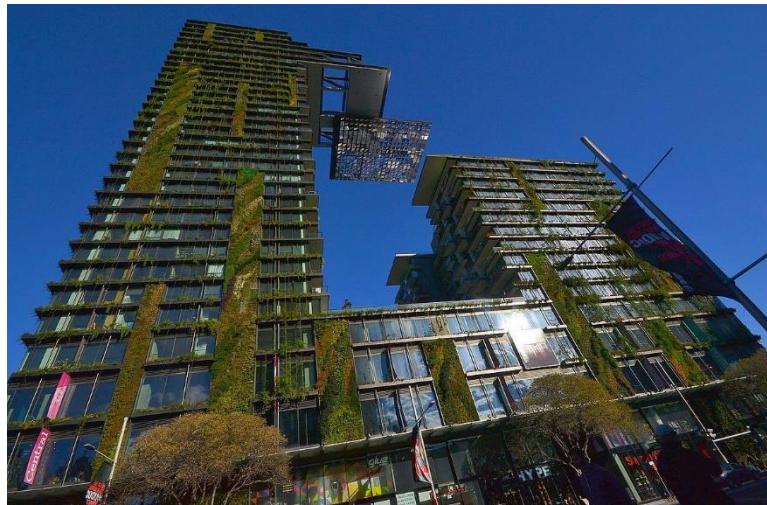

**CIB Co-Sponsored Invitation  
Smart and Sustainable Built Environments  
(SASBE2018) Conference  
4-7 December 2018, Sydney, Australia**



The fifth SASBE conference is hosted by Prof Rob Roggema and Kiran Kashyap at the University of Technology Sydney and will take place from 4-7 December 2018.

The deadline for abstract submissions and selected paper submission is already passed, but the program promises to be very interesting.

The major theme chosen for this edition of the conference is 'Do we own the land, or does the land own us?', a view often used by indigenous people in Australia. Because this expresses a view on how we use our environment sustainably and therefore gives meaning to the way we approach urban development, building and maintaining our urban environments, the conference organisers decided to not only pay tribute to the Australian ancestors but also (re)start a conversation with them to find mutual ground for a sustainable future.

The conference will therefore include abundant moments of discussion, conversation and reflection on this theme.

The conference starts with an informal welcome in the afternoon of 4 December, followed by two full conference days.

On 7 December several technical tours are offered.

The registration for the conference is now open and offers the possibility to take part in the discussions, present academic papers and join for one or two days of the conference.
